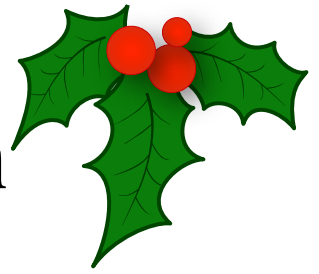
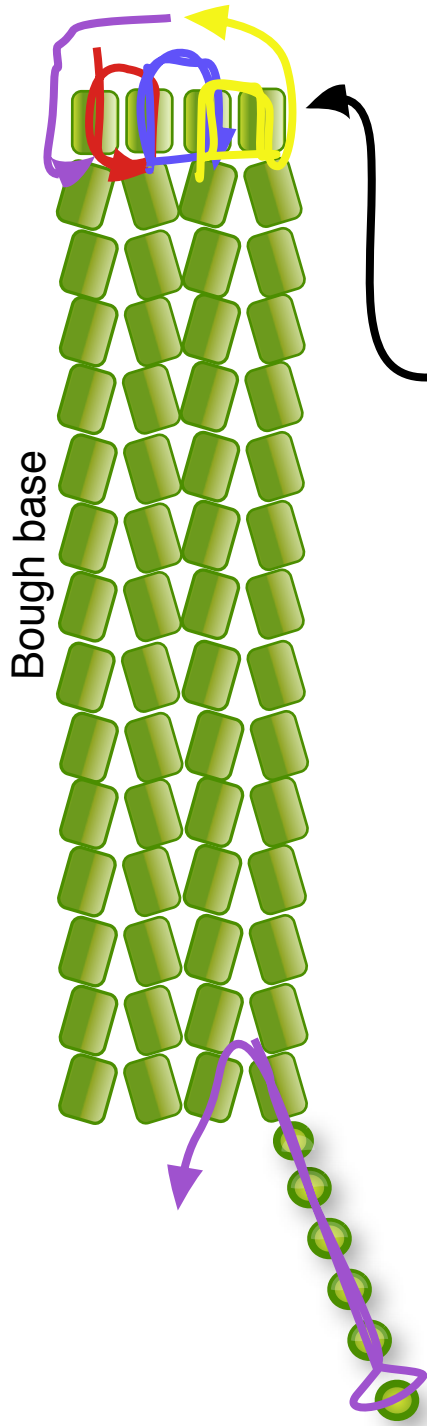

Pine Bough Pattern



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Use 4 10° or 11° beads to form a ladder stitch circle.

After creating a circle of the four beads, begin circular herringbone/Ndebele stitch. There will be two beads on each side of the circle. Remember to step up at the beginning of the circle. Make this herringbone 2/3-3/4 the length that you want your branch to be. When you reach the length you want, begin making fringe.

Add branch fringe to each of the 4 beads at the end of your bough by adding five 15° beads, going back through the first four. Then go through the next 11° bead and add a fringe to it. After adding five-bead fringes to all four beads, go up to the row above and add six-bead fringes. Keep going until you reach ten-bead fringes, then continue in the same manner with ten-bead fringes for the rest of the length of the branch.
